Steering Team Meeting Minutes

Welcome & Review Agenda

- The Lower Minnesota River East Meeting was held on Thursday, February 6th 2025. The meeting was held virtually.
- The agenda covers January JPB approval updates, reporting requirements, education and outreach updates, and a request for a workplan amendment.

Recap Last Meeting

 Last ST meeting we were finishing up some conversations and edits about a few additional items and documents that are needed prior to implementation efforts starting.

FY'25 CRP Incentive Grant Program

- Went to JPB for Approval at January 2025 Meeting
 - There were a few revisions and edits that the JPB suggested (the incentive funding suggested to be reduced). Additionally, they did not want the enrollment period to be a first come first serve. Applicants that are closed to water resources should be prioritized over others.
- Mike stated that the CRP program is up in the air now. We are waiting to see how the Farm Bill goes.
- The ST talked about the enrollment period and how it typically works.

LoMRE Reporting Implementation Efforts

- Project database
 - Each project or practice will be required to be entered into the project database excel spreadsheet.
 - Holly updated the eligible projects and practices that are listed in the drop down menu.
- This will be a trial period, and the ST will have to see if this database form will work.

 Additionally, the ST needs to make sure they can access the shared drive as that is where all documentation for projects and practices will need to be entered.

Legal Counsel RFP

- An update draft of the Legal Counsel RFP was provided to the ST.
- The timeline of the RFP shifted due to the JPB meeting quarterly.
 - RFP would be sent out in early March and the JPB would finalize the decision of the firm at the April JPB meeting.
- As of now, no projects have been completed, very low risk.
- The ST had no revisions or additional discussions on the document.
- The 3 year window for the length of the agreement was worked for the ST members.
- The RFP will go to the January JPB meeting for approval.

Education and Outreach Campaign Update

- Kourtney has developed a rough draft of the Education and Outreach Campaign Plan/Framework that is complete.
 - She received comments from Rice and Scott SWCD staff as well.
- Her goal is to have a Facebook page developed for the LoMRE by February.
- For the website, Kourtney has had some issues accessing it due to restrictions. Meghan and Kourtney were going to work on this.
 - Kourtney mentioned she would like to get photos of staff and board members to be included on the website.
- Mike wanted to share that a soil health meeting would be hosted in Le Center on February 26th which would include Scott SWCD as well.
 - He may need some funding to help for the event.
 - It is an eligible expense.
- Holly wanted to ask the ST if they would be supportive of a GIS story map of LoMRE efforts. ST members were in agreeance but wanted us to start small with just a point on a map with project information.
 - We will need to look into options on how to get this set up and who will be doing this.

Workplan Amendment Request

- Mike and Holly would like discussion amongst ST members prior to bring to JPB.
- We have a few projects that need feasibility studies prior to implementation. Holly provided additional details about the projects and how much they would cost.
 - Dam Removal-Le Sueur Creek (BMP.7)
 - Ravine Stabilization along Road (BMP.12)

- Suggest removing Stream Erosion Study and Lake/Stream Subwatershed Assessment under studies and assessments. Add under project development Complete 1 Stream Restoration Feasibility Study and Complete 1 Ravine Stabilization Feasibility Study.
 - Right now Le Sueur is working on a few of these projects with AIG funds and currently there is no interest from others to pursue these projects right now.
- Other suggestions to the workplan include adding funds for native planting projects and removing the water quality storage project.
- Holly recommended that everyone review the existing workplan and see if there are any
 other edits that the ST would like to make and funds to shift around.
 - We will discuss these at the March meeting.
- There was discussion about Holly checking in with BWSR to see what amendments require JPB approval.

Updates & Next Steps

- The Streambank Stabilization project is still moving forward and is in the works.
